



Important Information:

The calendar shows dates, and times of meetings, but does not reflect the full time it takes for each body to set up, take down, and socialize for their respective meetings. In order to clarfly the use of the hall, the following guides are being presented. they are NOT hard and fast "rules" as to when each body may show up, must leave, or shall typically have absolute right to exclude other persons or groups*. Cooperation is essential, and if there is a practice on a Thursday, with another body setting up for a Friday, then let's get along, and work around each other.

Blue Lodge:

Each Wednesday, reserved, typically evenings, from about 7 pm until 1 0 pm First Wednesday of each month for state meeting, cooking time (for whichever group is making the meal, from 1 pm until dinner, typically 5:30 pm).

Comfort Station:

Second Wednesday of each month, from 9 am untils 2 pm, to allow for setup, take down, and social (usually a pot luck lunch) time.

Eastern Star:

Some setup on Sunday, to work around any others using the lodge building. Cooking and more setup, Monday, from 1 pm to 5 pm, before the meeting. Open before meeting at 6:30 pm.

Royal Arch:

Second Thursday of each month, from 4 pm until 1 0 pm. Some setup time may be used, with cooperation with other groups using the lodge building, on the day before as well.

White Shrine:

Third Saturday of each month, from 1 pm until 1 0 pm, to allow for setup, take down and the meeting time itself.

Others, regularly scheduled:

Bridge Club:

Mondays and Fridays, from 1 1 am to 5 pm (typically 1 /2 hour less on each end), Tuesday 6:30 pm to 1 0 pm, and one Sunday each month, which they will work around others' schedules.

Any others will be schedule around the times shown, and will be allowed some additional time for set up and take down. As far as possible these will be put into the calendar each month, giving notice to all other users. THIS HAS BEEN PUT INTO THE TRESTLEBOARD AGAIN SO THAT WE CAN IMPRESS ON EVERYONE THAT WE WILL BE RENTING OUT THE HALL TO DEFRAY COSTS AND KEEP RENT FROM GOING UP. YOUR COOPERATION IS NOT ONLY APPRECIATED, IT IS NECESSARY, TO ACCOMPLISH THIS.
